<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Children are receiving Forest school sessions termly. These activities are carried out by Teachers and TA's. PP children will participate in small groups. Budget for this activity will be £300.</li>   <li>• Children are participating in 'Talk Boost' sessions to develop listening , understanding and speaking. This is carried out by an additional TA three times a week. Budget for this activity will be £150</li>   <li>• Children are receiving Musical mini sessions weekly, carried out by a TA to enhance PSED and CLL development. Budget for this activity will be £242</li>   <li>• Children are receiving extra support during their play activities.</li> </ul>	<p>This group of children tend to have little experience of exploring their environment beyond school. They also tend to be working at lower levels for PSED , CL and KUW. Therefore, we have set up Forest School. This will enable the children to learn about their outside environment. Team building and group working help develop skills in PSED.</p> <p><i>There were huge benefits for children taking part in Forest School this year. This provided children with greater knowledge of the outdoor environment and enriched their imagination for creativity outdoors. This enabled children to explore freely, learning at their own pace and offers more open ended learning opportunities. Children had opportunities to develop a herb garden, where we made perfume. They had the opportunity to grow fruit and vegetables, tasting them raw and then made into soup. As part of Forest School I offered children the chance to observe their surroundings and children gained confidence to suggest ideas for play such as making leaf crowns, painting natural objects and making fairy wands.</i></p> <p>Talk Boost sessions will help develop children's confidence to talk within a small group. It will enhance children's ability to understand questions and to be able to ask questions to extend their learning.</p> <p><i>Talk Boost sessions had a great impact on children's confidence, speech and listening and understanding. Children benefitted from taking a book home and sharing it with their parents, creating greater home school learning links for these children. Children and adults used puppets which helped children who were not confident as speaking or were shy to take part because the puppet gave them confidence to speak behind.</i></p>

To help develop PSED and CLL skills we will carry out weekly sessions of 'musical mini' in which children will learn to share and take turns, develop language skills through learning a range of songs.

*Musical Minis had a great impact on children's ability to take turns, share and respect others. Children's listening and attention skills greatly improved and helped them to be able to follow simple instructions.*

To help develop skills in Communication and Language, turn-taking and sharing, we are supporting children during their play. Additional adults work alongside targeted children, extending their play and developing children's understanding and use of language.
