### **Design and Technology**

#### ***Textiles - puppets***

Children will:

#### ***Which materials should the Three Little Pigs have used to build their house?***

Children will:

- Distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made.
- Identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock
- Describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials.
- Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials based on their simple physical properties.
- **Discussing suitability of materials for their purpose.**

### **French**

#### ***Greetings***

Children will:

- Learn greetings – hello and goodbye and respond appropriately.
- Ask others how they are and give a response to questions.
- Sing a song in French.
- Learn how to say familiar words in French.

Children will:
